

## IU Post 9/11 GI Bill Yellow Ribbon Program Application AY 2009-2010

Indiana University will provide up to \$2,000 per academic year (\$1,000 per regular term) with funds matched by the US Department of Veterans Affairs for up to 20 qualified applicants.

**Criteria:**

- Eligible for Ch 33 Post 9/11 GI Bill education benefits at the 100% level
- Maintain good academic standing at IU
- Be admitted as a degree-seeking student with tuition and fee charges above the VA's maximum in-state undergraduate rate as posted at [www.gibill.va.gov](http://www.gibill.va.gov)

If you believe you are eligible, you should apply immediately. Awards to qualified applicants are on a first-come basis established by the date and time your application is received by the Veterans Support Services office.

You must provide follow-up documentation of your CH 33 Certificate of Eligibility OR proof of application for CH 33 plus your DD214 by July 15, 2009. We will continue to accept applications beyond July 15<sup>th</sup> until all slots are filled.

Funds will not be disbursed until our office receives a copy of your Certificate of Eligibility.
